The value of a convalescence day is according to the value of a convalescence day in the private sector – 418 NIS today





Employees shall be entitled to sick pay as specified below:

- In the first two years of employment in the sector in Israel in accordance with the provisions of the Sick Pay Law, 5737-1976 (accumulation of up to 18 sick days per year).
- <u>Starting from the third year of employment in the sector in Israel</u>, the employee shall be entitled to 25 sick days per year and to a maximum accumulation of 161 days.

Holiday Vacation Days

An employee is entitled to be absent from work during a holiday observed by his religion, on the employer's account, on a scope of up to 9 holiday days per year, plus an additional elective day, and 10 paid days in the aggregate.

An employee with tenure of at least 3 work months in the sector in Israel, who was not absent from work without permission on the day before or the day after the holiday, shall be entitled to paid vacation on the holiday day, on a scope of up to 9 holiday days per year as stated, plus an elective day.

Holiday Gift

Twice a year, on Rosh Hashana and Pesach. - 300 NIS each.
